THREE-YEAR DOCTORAL PROGRAM

Restore and enhance everyday occupations for patients who have experienced injury, disease, or illness. In our hands-on OTD program, students engage in a comprehensive mix of classroom learning, lab work, clinical experience, and service-based community involvement.

TWO-YEAR GRADUATE PROGRAM

Physician assistants perform many of the same duties as an MD—diagnose illnesses, prescribe medications, assist in surgery—but with less school time. Physician assistants serve in almost every area of medicine, and our PA program at PC prepares students to start making an impact immediately.
