- _____ A **directed study (442/4005)** requires a minimum GPA of 2.25 with course approval by the Provost prior to the semester in which it is taken. Each directed study will culminate in a research paper or its equivalent and is normally open to departmental majors with junior or senior standing.
- _____ An **independent study** requires a minimum GPA of 2.25 with course approval by the Provost prior to the semester in which it is taken. Only courses currently in the College curriculum may be taken as an independent study.
- _____ **Selected readings (446/4004)** are open to students with sophomore, junior, or senior standing. Hours earned in these readings cannot be used to meet requirements for the major.
- _____ **Research (448/4004)** in certain departments is offered for students with a GPA of 2.50 (or higher if specified). Research projects are normally open only to majors.
- _____ **Seminars (450/4000/4001/4006/4790)** are regularly offered by various departments of the College. The requirements for these courses are individually listed.
- _____ **Special Projects (452/4002/4006)** are open to sophomore, junior, or senior students who have a GPA of 2.25. All projects must be approved by the Provost.
