Financial Need Estimator Service

College is expensive, and this expense is certainly a concern to all students and parents. However, there are many sources of aid available. We at Presbyterian College feel no student should be denied access to college solely on the basis of cost.

Most financial aid is based on a family's ability to pay or its *financial need*. To determine *need*, a national formula has been developed which takes into consideration not only family income, assets, size, and other extenuating circumstances, but also the cost of the college. *Students attending higher priced institutions will automatically demonstrate a higher need and qualify for more aid.*

The purpose of this service is to provide an estimate of your financial need at Presbyterian College. The official funds received will be based on the completed and submitted Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the information herein. Any figures given on this estimated financial need form are subject to change dependent on the accuracy of the information as compared to that provided on the official FAFSA form. All information will be kept confidential.

NOTE: This form is NOT an application for Financial Aid. You must still complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (as soon after January 1 as possible) to be considered for financial aid.
