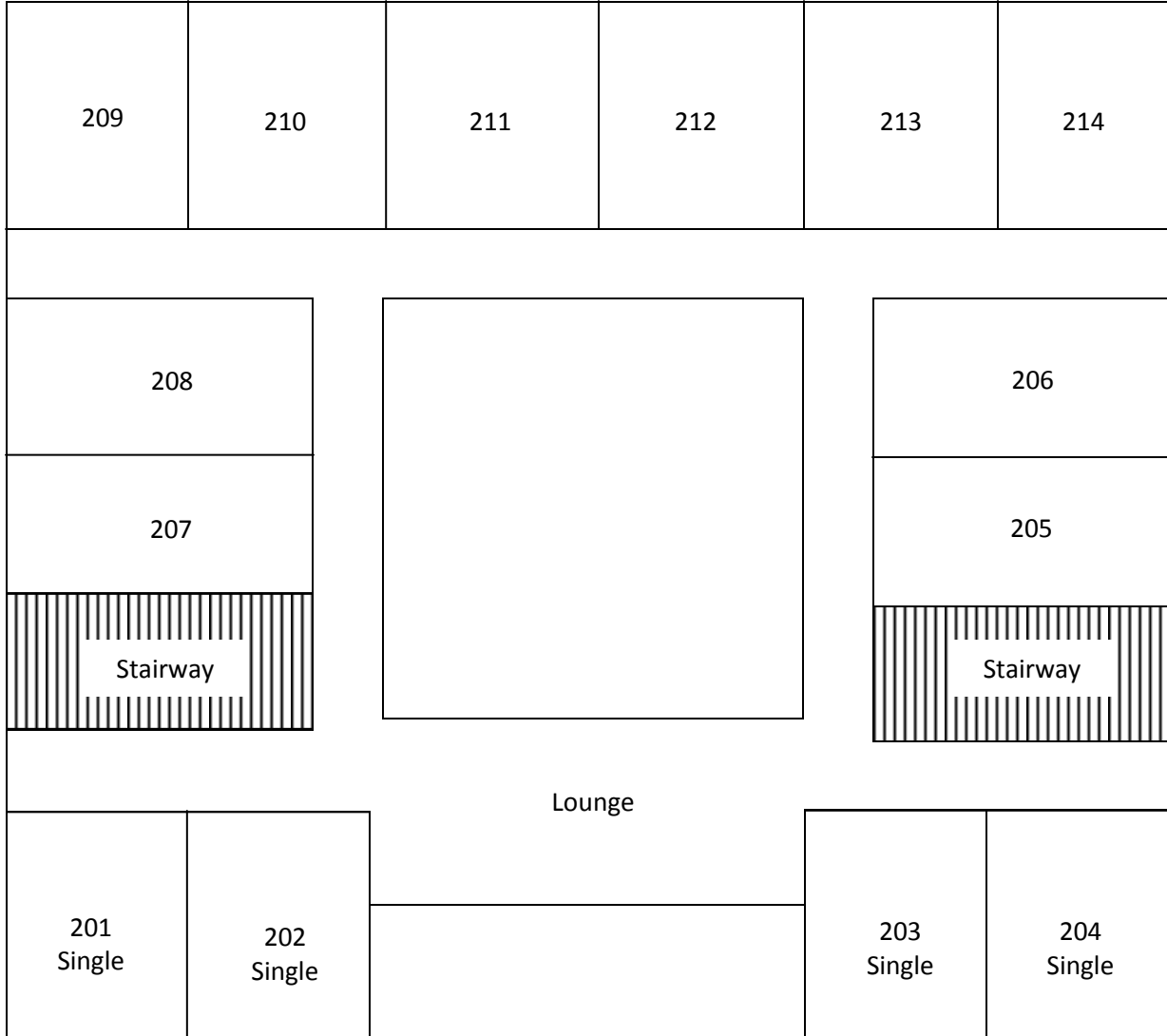


CAROL INTERNATIONAL HOUSE

Description of Room

Your room is air-conditioned.

FURNISHINGS: Twin beds that may be bunked with regular mattresses, mirrors, bookshelves, built in desks with adequate lighting, desk chairs, two closets and a wastebasket.

WINDOW: Each room has at least one window with a venetian blind.

BATHROOM: One bathroom per room (two people) with a tub/shower.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING: Bed linens, blankets, pillow, towels, alarm clock, etc. The room is not carpeted.

ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES: Appliances which *are allowed* in the room include TVs, stereos, microwaves, hair dryers, alarm clocks, refrigerators under 4.2 cubic feet, lamps, etc. Appliances which *are not allowed* in the room include air conditioners, halogen lamps, any cooking device which has an open heating surface (hot plates, portable stoves, etc.) or which is not thermostatically controlled (some coffee makers, toasters, etc.) and refrigerators over 4.2 cubic feet.

ELECTRICAL OUTLETS: Each room has 6 outlets plus 2 outlets built into the desk lights with a total of 14 three-pronged receptacles. If you have more appliances than this, you will need to bring a power strip.

STORAGE: You will have to store all belongings in your own room. Attic storage is not available.

PHONE: Each room has a phone jack; students must bring their own phone. Local service is provided.

LAUNDRY: Washers and dryers are located in Browns Commons; they are free for students.

CABLE TV: Basic cable has been installed in each room. The main lobby on the first floor has a TV for student use.

COMPUTER ACCESS: Each room has 2 ethernet jacks so that you can plug into the campus network and internet.

ROOM DIMENSIONS: Room – 19'8" x 13'2" ; Window – 6'x 4'
