### Disclosure of Directory Information

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 (as amended) designates certain information about students at "directory information" and gives the College the right to disclose this information. Under the provision of FERPA, you have the right to withhold the disclosure of this information. Below is a list of what the College designates as directory information:

- Full name
- Addresses (local, permanent, email)
- Local phone number
- Major field of study
- Photograph
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- Weight and height (for members of athletic teams)
- Dates of attendance
- Classification
- Degree(s) and awards/honors received

If you so choose, the College will not disclose this information. However, please consider carefully the consequences of your decision. Here are a few examples of information we would not release if you request that we withhold your directory information:

- We would be unable to perform a verification of enrollment, degree verification, etc. by phone.
- Your name would not be included on any Dean's or President's Lists that are sent to local newspapers.
- Your name and contact information would not be included on our web directory.

Presbyterian College will honor your request to withhold the information listed above but cannot assume responsibility to contact you for subsequent permission to release that information. By signifying below, the request to withhold this information becomes valid until a written request to rescind is received by the Registrar's office.

### Disclosure of Information to Parents/Guardians

If you are an IRS-dependent of your parent/guardian, regardless of your age, your parent/guardian has access to your educational record(s). However, if you are not an IRS dependent, you may instruct the College to withhold this information from your parent/guardian.
