COURSE OFFERINGS

The Southern Immersion Semester includes several required Intensive English (IENG) courses. These are exclusively for SIS participants. The required courses include Listening and Speaking (IENG 1021) and either a writing or reading course (IENG 1022 or IENG 1023). In addition to these courses, you will choose your remaining classes from a list of elective courses. These elective courses may include film studies, biology, English composition, business, history, and more. You will enroll with Presbyterian College students for the elective courses. This provides an excellent opportunity for you to meet new people and truly experience life as a college student in the American South.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Deadline for fall semester admission is early May.

Deadline to apply for spring semester admission is early November.
