



Summer Immersion Program

Located on a beautiful 240-acre campus between two major cities in South Carolina in the heart of the Southeast, Presbyterian College (PC) offers a unique cultural experience. The Summer Immersion Program allows international students to improve their English skills and explore a historic part of the United States.

WHY PC?

PC, was founded in 1880 and is among the Southeast's top liberal arts colleges. With only 1,200 students, it has a welcoming, family-like atmosphere. PC is located in Clinton, South Carolina, a small town only an hour away from major shopping and cultural destinations.

WHY TAKE A PRE-TERM COURSE?

Languages thrive in a culture, not simply in a classroom. PC's 4-week Summer Immersion Program (SIP) helps students acclimate to conversational English and daily life in America before their university program.

You will have the chance to learn and practice effective communication skills in an intimate, student-focused environment. You will explore a remarkable area of the country and build meaningful relationships with PC faculty and American students.

INSTRUCTION

The program is designed to raise your English competency and introduce them to the academic skills expected of American university students. It includes 60 hours of classroom instruction, as well as extensive conversation sessions. The small class size provides an excellent setting for discussion. In addition, students

learn valuable research methods and are able to attend a variety of lectures from exceptional faculty.

DISCOVER THE SOUTH

PC is located in the heart of a region rich in history that is known for its friendly culture and tradition of southern hospitality. SIP will introduce you to the culture and society of this unique region through a variety of activities, including:

- In-class assignments and projects
- Literature, movie, and music discussions
- Local excursions
- Special lectures

LOCAL EXCURSIONS

In addition to weekly trips, the program includes regional excursions. Some of the places SIP participants have visited in the past include Greenville and Charleston in South Carolina; Atlanta, Georgia; and Asheville in the mountains of North Carolina.

ACCOMMODATION

You will be provided with on-campus university housing that is equipped with laundry rooms. The College will help coordinate meals, shopping and other needs.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To apply, you must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate institution.

Note: Students participating in the SIP who plan to enroll at Presbyterian College will have further PC language requirements waived for the following school year.

The four-week English Immersion Program lasts from July to August. The deadline to apply for this program is May 15.

PROGRAM FEE

The overall fee for the program is \$2,500 (US). This fee includes:

- All activities and excursions
- Airport pick-up service
- Library and computer lab access
- Access to on-campus gym, sports fields, & laundry facilities
