DEPARTMENTAL HONORS PROGRAM/RESEARCH Guidelines

1. Student requesting honors research must have a GPA of 3.20 in all courses and a 3.40 GPA in major courses.
2. The topic for study should be selected in consultation with the faculty advisor.
3. A prospectus should be prepared and submitted to the department for approval prior to registration for the term of study.
4. All department members must approve research proposal.
5. Research may be undertaken during the fall or spring semester or may be undertaken during a summer term and completed in the fall term.
6. Completion of the senior thesis or project should be of exceptional quality.
7. Oral defense of paper/project should be made before department members and open to college community. Honors students participate in all other defenses within their discipline.
8. Minimum of three hours and maximum of six hours credit granted for honors research program.
9. The work will be appropriately designated on the student's diploma and transcript.
10. Upon completion of all aspects of the program, the department chair should submit appropriate form to the Registrar for recording.
11. Faculty advisor will receive additional compensation for the supervisor of honors research work at the end of the academic year.
