Students participating in this program will be expected to complete all Presbyterian College General Education requirements and all Presbyterian College School of Pharmacy pre-requisites. Students will complete a minimum of 76 hours of credit, and following successful application and acceptance into PCSP, will continue to pursue the BS degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences by completing the first two years of coursework in the PCSP PharmD program. All PCSP prerequisites must be completed with a grade of "C" or better, and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for admission to the program.
