2020 PC Summer Fellows Application Instructions

(Please read complete instructions before preparing the application. Applications not correctly formatted will not be reviewed)

I. STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- Summer Fellows must commit to 8 full weeks of research or research related activities during the duration of the program. The program will run from June 1st to July 24th.
- Summer Fellows must commit to spending *at least* 25 hours per week devoted to their research project.
- Students must live on campus, with the other Summer Fellows, during the program. Housing is included in the fellowship.
- Summer Fellows must present research at the PC Summer Research Symposium and Honors Day in 2021.

II. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS

- Students graduating prior to the program are not eligible for the fellowship.
- Students may not take summer school while participating in the program.
- Students may not have other employment, on or off campus, during the program.

III- PROPOSAL DOCUMENTS

- 1) Application Form (on next page)
- 2) Proposal Plan (4 pages maximum):
Student Contribution - (i) the relevance of the research project, (ii) the details of the proposed research. (iii) Bibliography. *The student researcher must write this portion.*
Student/Mentor Contribution – (iii) research and learning objectives, (iv) research time line/plan, (v) budget (for program future projection).
- 3) Letter of Support - from research mentor reflecting the student's aptitude to conduct the project and a statement of the mentor's commitment to meet regularly with the Fellow, to participate in a weekly luncheon/forum, and to attend the Summer Fellows Symposium.
- 4) *(Optional)* Supplemental Letter of Support- If the mentor is unfamiliar with the applicant's potential a letter from another faculty member is required.

IV – PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

- **Proposal plan must include the specified sections.**
- **Students should combine the above 3-4 documents and save in a single pdf format and name the file in the following format PCSFAppI_LastnameFirstname.**
- **Submit the completed pdf document via email to Ms. Shannon Latimore slattimore@presby.edu with copy to Dr. Ray pray@presby.edu by January 31st**
- **Applications that fail to follow these instructions will NOT be reviewed.**
