

## Summer Housing Information 2019

### Off-Campus Students (Commuter Students)

- Any student not residing in campus housing during the summer school sessions must provide summer contact information on the Summer School Housing Information Form.

### Policies for Summer Students

- **All policies found in the *Garnet Book* and *PC Housing Contract* are in place for Summer School.** In addition, there are some policies specifically in place for Summer School.
- There are no social events registered at Fraternity Court. No access is permitted to ANY residential area, including fraternity houses, with the exception of the facilities to which students are assigned.
- RAs will conduct Health and Safety inspections at the mid-point of the summer term.
- All residents will need to check out of their rooms according to stated guidelines with an RA at the end of each term of summer school.
- All PC students enrolled for Summer School or Summer Fellows must not interfere with the operation of Summer Programs unless they are serving in an official capacity assisting with Summer Programs.

### Cost of Summer School Housing and Dining

- The cost of on-campus housing is \$930.00/person each term.
- The cost of housing does not include meals. Students living on campus for Summer Session One and/or Two will be required to purchase a meal plan for the dining hall which will operate each day of the week for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The cost of the Summer Meal Plans are: \$550.00 (Summer I) and \$550.00 (Summer II).

### Summer Housing Details

- On-campus housing is NOT mandatory for summer school students
- Housing is assigned on a first come-first serve basis. Spaces are limited and not guaranteed.
- Students taking only online classes will not be able to live on campus during the summer sessions.
- On-campus housing will be pre-assigned, and students will be informed prior to check-in.
- Please include specific roommate requests in the appropriate section on the Summer School Housing Form. Residence Life will work to honor these requests whenever possible. A very limited number of singles is available, so you are encouraged to identify a potential roommate.
- Summer Session I will be housed in CIH. Priority deadline for applications is Friday, May 17, 2019.
- Summer Session II will be housed in Georgia Hall. Priority deadline for applications is Friday, June 21, 2019.
- Students living on campus for other reasons will receive information from their program coordinator.

### Check-In Details

- Students who live on-campus during Summer Session I must check-in and pick up their keys from the Residence Life Office on **Sunday, June 2, 2019** from **12:00 noon-6:00 p.m.**
- Students who live on-campus during Summer Session II must check-in and pick up their keys from the Residence Life Office on **Sunday, July 7, 2019** from **12:00 noon-6:00 p.m.**
- Students cannot move-in prior to these dates, so please plan accordingly. Exception: Students moving from Summer I to Summer II housing will be given earlier access to move into their new rooms.
- Students living on campus for other reasons will receive check-in information from their program coordinator.
